Statement of Significant Changes for the

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## Introduction

The Statement of Significant Changes for the 2019/20 Household Charges Scheme sets out any significant changes in charging policy for 2019/20 and whether any end customers' bill is expected to increase by more than 5% from the previous year. Our Household Charges Scheme, published separately, set out our full charging policies.

## Analysis of Bill changes

Wessex Water does not expect any bill increase of more than 5% from the previous year where the customer's use of our services remains constant. To assure itself of this, the company has assessed bill changes across the entire range of the company's tariffs and across all ranges of consumption or rateable value.
