In 2018 we are celebrating 25 years of the Watermark awards with the Conservation Foundation. And we are offering a special fund to communities who need help in providing a refill point for water, in order to reduce the number of single-use plastic bottles.


If you have a project in mind and are based in the Wessex Water supply region, you could apply for a grant of up to £1,500 towards it.

All applications are judged by a panel of experts from the Conservation Foundation which is chaired by botanist, television presenter and the foundation's co-founder, David Bellamy.

In 1993, Wessex Water launched the Watermark award scheme. It has helped all kinds of organisations apply for financial assistance to carry out environmental projects. - action groups
- amenity groups
- environmental and conservation groups.

How do I apply?

If you're planning, or have already started, a project that aims to provide a refill point for your community, apply for a grant by completing the form below, including a brief description of your project.

You are welcome to attach supporting material, such as budgets, press cuttings and photographs.

Please complete and return the application form by email or post to the Conservation Foundation. Please include postage and packaging if you enclose supporting material and would like it returned.

Your entry will be acknowledged by the Conservation Foundation on behalf of Wessex Water, who will send you an entry number.
