What is it?

We've been running the Watermark environmental grant scheme for 25 years.

It helps all kinds of organisations, groups and schools apply for financial help when carrying out environmental projects.

This includes building nature gardens, constructing ponds or generally just bringing people closer to nature.

If you represent a school, parish council or community organisation, are based in our region and have an environmental project in mind, you could apply for a grant of up to £1,500 towards it.

All applications are judged by a panel of experts from the Conservation Foundation, chaired by botanist, television presenter and the foundation's co-founder, David Bellamy.

Who can apply?

Your project must be located in our region (Bath, Bristol, Dorset, Somerset, Wiltshire and parts of Hampshire and South Gloucestershire).

Groups and organisations eligible to apply include:

- parish, village and town councils
- action groups
- amenity groups
- youth groups
- Guide and Scout groups
- schools and colleges
- heritage groups
- environmental and conservation groups.

How do I apply?


